

Year 7 Catch-Up Strategic Spending Plan 2019-20

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium provides schools with additional funding to support Year 7 students who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or mathematics prior to joining the academy. This funding is intended to support these students in catching up with their peers during their first year in the academy. The following costs detail our strategies for achieving this in the 2019/20 academic year.

| 1. | All students in the literacy group rapidly improve their reading and writing to bring them in line with their peers. | Star Reader standardised test results show the group narrowing the gap to their NRSS (based around 100). | 2. | Spelling of commonly misspelt words improves for the identified group, and for all students in the year group. | Planner checks show that spelling mistakes are being recorded on an ongoing basis. Spelling Bee results show improvement from first test to second test for identified group and for year group as a whole. | |
| 3. | Reading progress is tracked carefully through the school, with no dip post-y7. | Star Reader standardised test results show students narrowing the gap to their NRSS (based around 100). | |



| 4. | Students not meeting the expected standard in Maths consolidate the basic Maths concepts needed for KS3. | Students successfully complete "Power of 2" programme. Summative assessments show improvement over the year. |
