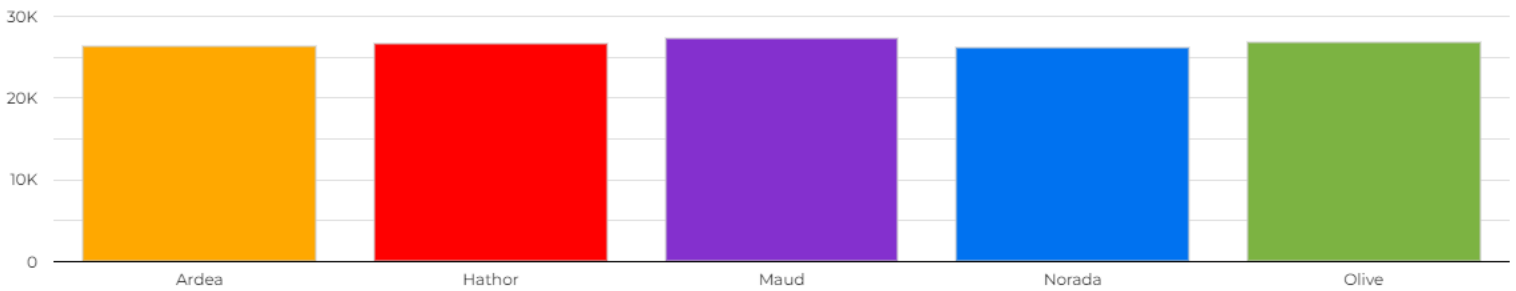

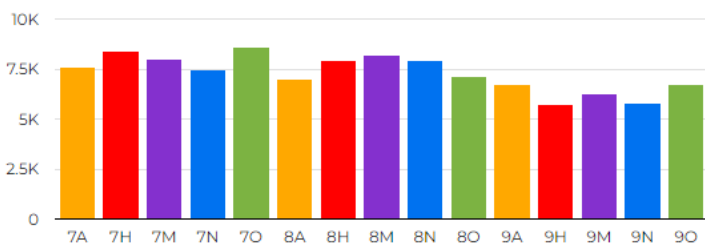

## House Point Leaderboard

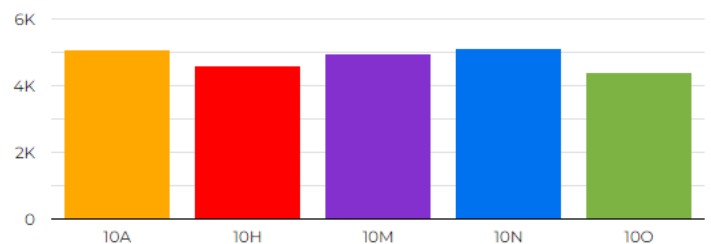
Overall House Points

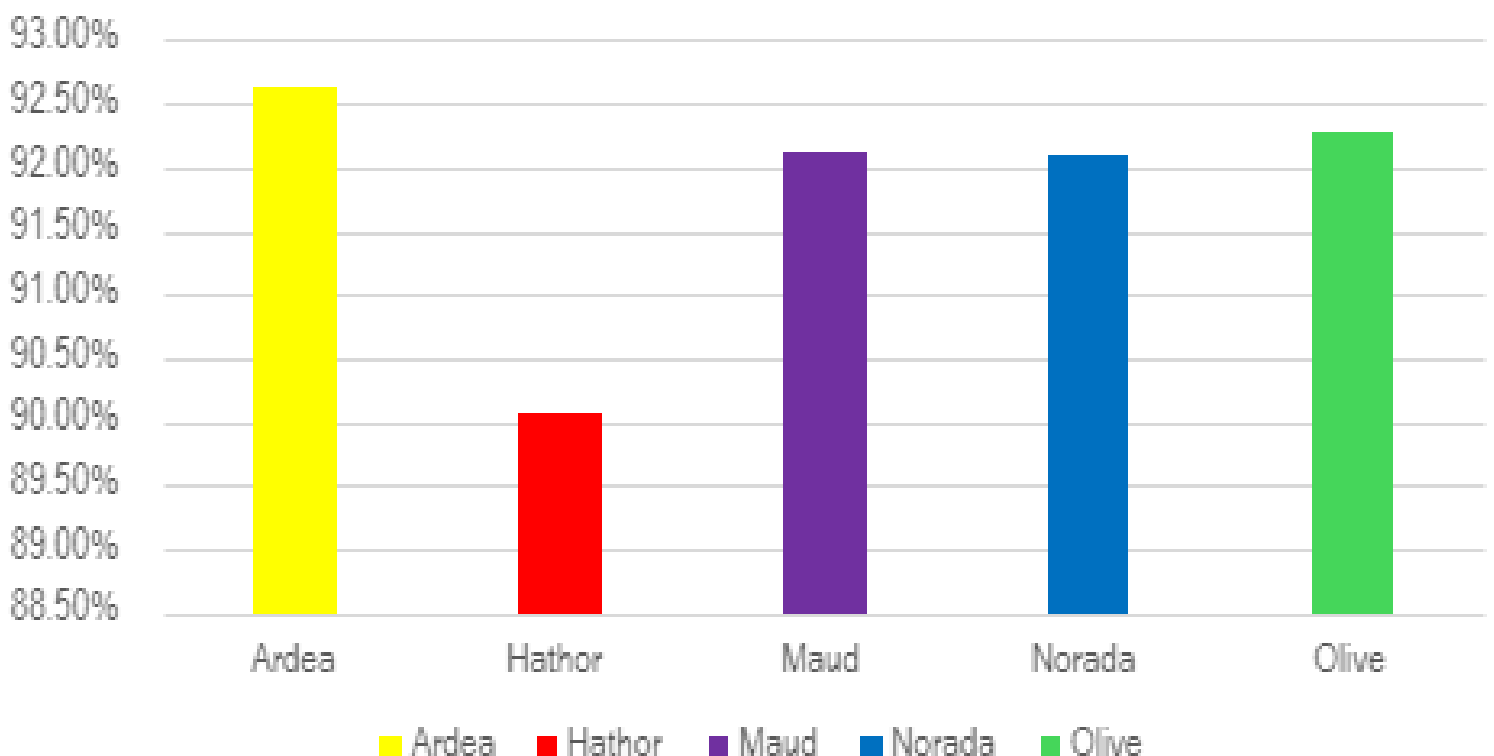
### Key Stage 3 Forms
