Year 10: Human Rights and Laws

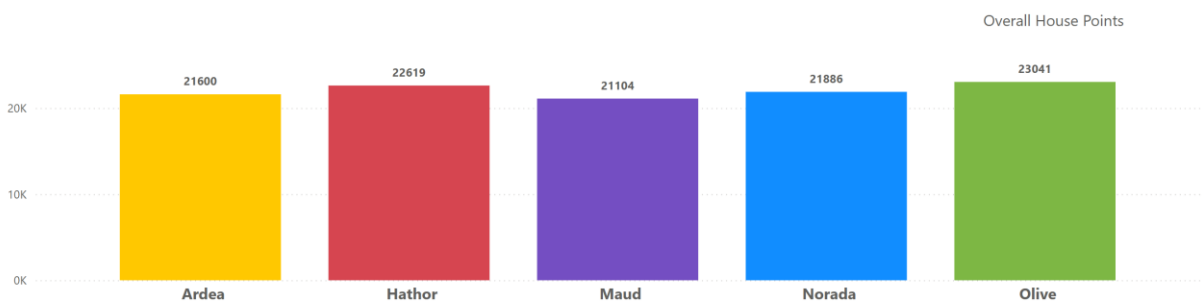
Year 11: Mental Health and Healthy Balances

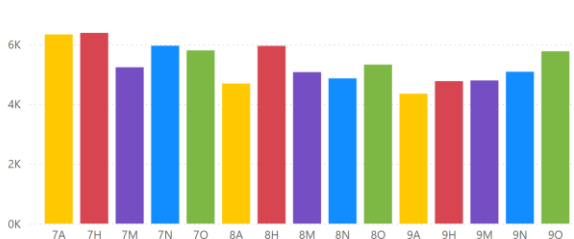

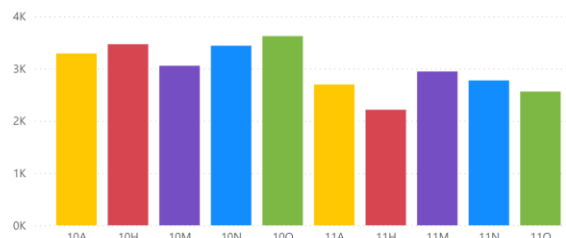
